Co-Product



Wheat Midds from the milling process are combined with wheat-based distillers' grains from the biofuels process to create Wet Distillers Grain with solubles (WDGS) and Dry Distillers Grain with solubles (DDGS). The result is valuable, year-round feed with high levels of nutrition.



Components

Wheat Midds are a co-product of the milling of wheat into flour. The particle size differs as different amounts of endosperm, bran, and germ from the wheat kernel are broken down.

Local farmers and feedlots utilize **WDGS** to feed large amounts of cattle at a lower cost.

DDGS are a longer-lasting nutrition option. The lower moisture levels allow for the product to be packaged and transported farther distances.
